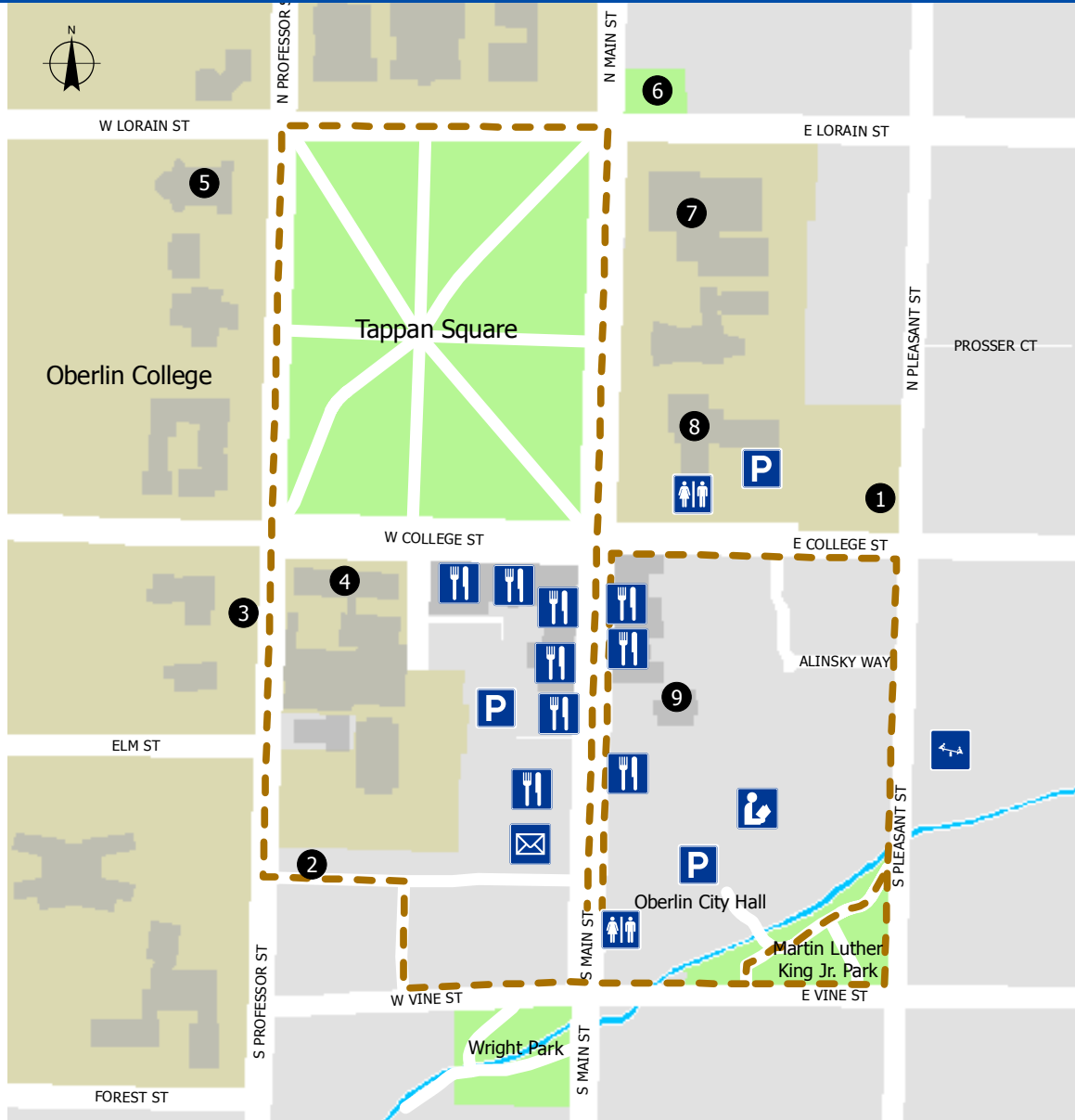


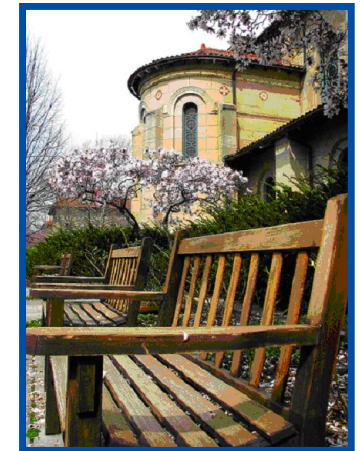

The route includes access to practical locations such as the library, theater, post office, beauty salon, florist, banks, and churches. Special points of interest include Oberlin College and historical landmark buildings such as Finney Chapel, Charles Martin Hall House, Charles Martin Hall House, and the Allen Memorial Art Museum.
